

# Activity 11: Letters, Letters, Everywhere



**Activity 11:** Building alphabet recognition is an important step in learning to read. In this activity called, “Letters, Letters, Everywhere”, your child will begin to recognize and identify letters of the alphabet.

**What does it build?** Letter recognition and identification, gross motor skills

**Materials:** Print found all around!

**How to Play?**

1. Begin every day by singing along to one of our FUN, upbeat alphabet songs from Mr. Wee and Boo’s Wee-phabet Songs With a Fun Twist!
2. Next, tell your child today you are both going to look for letters, letters, everywhere – in the house, while driving in the car, at the grocery store, places near and far! Then choose a letter (or two or three) to focus on that day.
3. Everytime you see one of the letters of the day, tell your child you will march, jump up, clap, or turn around. Ex: As you are walking through the aisles at the grocery store, every time you see the letter ‘C’ turn around. When you see the letter ‘D’ jump up and down, etc.
4. Your child will have a ball (and develop motor skills, too) while learning and practicing identifying the letters of the alphabet.
