

ABC Song Activity 1: Tic Tac Wee-phabet



Activity 1

Help your child identify the alphabet letter names and sounds, along with naming a word that has the sound in it by playing “Tic Tac Wee-phabet.” Your child is going to love this version of tic-tac-toe using our Wee-phabet flashcards! Learning all about the alphabet is the goal. (Printable: Wee-phabet flashcards)

Grades: PreK – 1

Goals:

- Recognize and identify the letters of the alphabet
- Name a word with the sound in the beginning, middle, or ending

Materials: Wee-phabet flashcards, Mr. Wee and Boo’s Wee-phabet Songs with a Fun Twist

Let’s Play:

1. Choose 25 Wee-phabet flashcards (printable from our website)
2. Shuffle the flashcards and place them in 5 rows of 5 on the floor.
3. Child chooses one of the flashcards from the floor, then identifies the letter, it’s sound, and names a word which has the sound in the beginning, middle, or end (depending on the level of your child’s understanding and development).
4. If the child knows the letter name, its sound, and a word that has the sound, they will place a raisin, bean, or token on the Wee-phabet flashcard.
5. Now it’s the parent’s turn. You will follow the steps your child took above. *It’s okay to “get help” from your child. They’ll love that they can “teach” you!
6. The first one to get a Tic Tac Wee-phabet (before two of our songs are over) is the king or queen of Wee-phabet Land!
