

ABC Song Activity 3: Wee-phabet Scavenger Hunt



Activity 3

Your child will join Mr. Wee and Boo's "Wee-phabet Scavenger Hunt", looking for objects around the house that begin with the letters of the alphabet. See how many objects can be found as your child marches around the house listening to Yankee Doodle's ABCs.

The fun will begin when the ABC song does, but when the song is over, the alphabet letter search must stop.

Grades: PreK – 2

Goals:

- Recognize and identify the letters of the alphabet
- Identify beginning, middle, or ending sounds

Materials: Mr. Wee and Boo's Wee-phabet Songs With A Fun Twist (ABC song CD), reading reading pointer, and a backpack or large brown paper bag.

Let's Play:

1. Before choosing one of the songs from our ABC song CD, explain the goal of the activity. Example: Look for objects around the house that begin with today's letter sound /b/, like "baseball bat".
2. After you have explained and shown a couple of examples, then start the ABC song you have chosen and let your child's Wee-phabet Scavenger Hunt begin as he scurries around the room looking for all the things he can find that begin with the letter sound you have chosen. Help your child remember the chosen letter by saying "B /b/ B /b/" throughout the activity.

Tip: Show your enthusiasm and excitement and your child will get excited too!
