

ABC Song Activity 4: BIG LETTER, little letter



Activity 4

Some things are BIG and some are little. Your child will learn that letters are no different. In this activity your child will distinguish the difference between UPPERCASE and lowercase letters of the alphabet. This activity involves lots of movement like skipping, hopping, and dancing around the room as your child listens to one of his favorite little ditties from Mr. Wee and Boo's Wee-phabet Songs With A Fun Twist!

Grades: PreK – 2

Goals:

- Recognize, identify, and distinguish uppercase and lowercase letters of the alphabet

Materials: Mr. Wee and Boo's Wee-phabet Songs With A Fun Twist (ABC song CD),

Printable: Wee-phabet flashcards.

Let's Play:

1. Divide the Wee-phabet flashcards into two stacks (uppercase and lowercase).
2. Shuffle the stack of uppercase letter flashcards, then hand the stack to your child.
3. Next, you will place the lowercase flashcards next to objects around the room that match each individual lowercase letter flashcard. (For beginning learners, you could place lowercase flashcards in a straight line on the floor)
4. When our ABC songs CD begins, your child flips over the first card in his uppercase stack, identify its name (and sound if he knows it), and then skips, hops, or dances around the room trying to find the "little letter" that matches his "BIG LETTER".
5. When a matching lowercase letter is found, the child collects the card and skips, hops, or dances back to the starting point.
6. Your child will choose a new card from the uppercase letter stack and repeat the above until all letters are matched or until the song is over.
