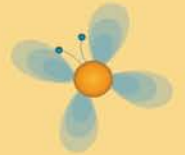


Activity 4: Discovering Baby



Activity 4: “Discovering Baby” is an activity that builds logic and reasoning in your precious baby. Your baby will begin to discover that he can figure out things by using tools and resources.

What does it build? Logic & reasoning

Materials: Your baby’s blanket and a favorite toy

How to Play:

1. Sit on the floor with your baby and play together with his favorite toy. This will spark his interest and build on the rest of the activity.
2. Then place the favorite toy on top of the baby’s blanket. Place the toy far enough away (on the blanket) that your baby cannot reach it.
3. Model the outcome you’d like to see. Tell your baby *“Oh, I can’t reach the toy. How am I going to get it?”* While saying this, reach for the toy, pretending you are not able to get it. Then (as if you’ve figured it out) use the blanket to pull the toy towards you. *“There we go. Pull the blanket to get your toy. Pull, pull, pull!”* Repeat over and over, then guide your baby into doing it.
