

ABC Book Activity 5: My Wee-phabet Book



Activity 5

In “My Wee-phabet Book”, your child will create his own ABC collage of pictures as he demonstrates his knowledge of the letters and sounds.

Grades: preK-3rd

Goals:

- Reinforcing letter names, shapes, and sounds

Materials: *Mr. Wee and Boo’s Wee-phabet Adventure* by Danielle Rivera & Emmanuel Colliot, 24 sheets of unlined paper, pictures from old magazines, scissors, glue, crayons, and yarn

Let’s Play:

1. Using the 24 sheets of unlined paper, have your child write (or trace) the letters of the alphabet and bind the pages together to make a Wee-phabet book.
2. Look for pictures in old magazines or have even more FUN with this and help your child take pictures of real things around the park, zoo, or on vacation (find things that start with each letters of the alphabet) and help your child glue the pictures onto the pages of the Wee-phabet book he is creating. Encourage your child to have multiple pictures of objects beginning with each sound (a collage of pictures).
3. Once the book is completed, “read” it together.
