

# ABC Song Activity 7: Guess My Name, Guess My Sound!



## Activity 6

“Guess My Name, Guess My Sound!” is another challenging activity that will raise the bar for those children who are already able to point out the letters on an alphabet chart. Parents provide the clues (as challenging as your child can handle) in this activity which builds listening and higher level thinking skills.

**Grades:** PreK – 2

**Goal:**

- Recognize and identify the letters of the alphabet
- Recognize and identify letter sounds (or blends to make it more challenging)

**Materials:** Printable Wee-phabet mat (optional)

**Let's Play:**

1. Choose a letter or sound which you would like your child to focus on.
2. Think of clues which would describe this letter or sound.

Example: Guess My Name - I am a vowel. I look like a tent. I am the first letter in the name of a red fruit. My sound is /ā/. I am the first letter of the alphabet. Guess my name, guess my sound!

Your child may use the Wee-phabet mat or an ABC book as he looks for a letter that matches these clues.

3. Continue with a different letter and clues.
