

ABC Song Activity 8: Ready, Set, Search!



Activity 8

A letter search using an ABC book, magazine, newspaper, or cereal box – which ever your child chooses to use in this game called “Ready, Set, Search!” Your child will continue building his letter identification skills as letters of the alphabet or found in any text.

Grades: PreK – 1

Goal:

- Recognize and identify the sounds and letters of the alphabet
- Match letter/sounds to words

Materials: Reading material such as an ABC book, magazine, newspaper, or cereal box; crayons or wax sticks, and Mr. Wee and Boo’s Wee-phabet Songs With A Fun Twist

Let’s Play:

1. Choose one of the reading materials from above and give your child a crayon or wax stick to use as they get ready to search for words that have the “letter of the day” (or week). Example: Today’s letter is the letter ‘B’.
2. Tell your child when the song begins, he will use his crayon (or wax stick) to circle all the words in the ABC book, magazine, newspaper, or cereal box. Then start the ABC song CD.
3. When the song is over, your child stops. Together, you and your child will count all the words he found.
