

ABC Song Activity 9: When You Hear...and Freeze!



Activity 9

This game helps teach your child to listen for words with the identified letter sound. “When You Hear...and Freeze” incorporates lots of movement and listening skills as the words are being shouted out in the song.

Grades: PreK – 1

Goal:

- Recognize and identify the sounds and letters of the alphabet
- Match letter/sounds to words
- Increase listening skills

Materials: Mr. Wee and Boo’s Wee-phabet Songs With A Fun Twist and Wee-phabet Song cards

Let’s Play:

1. Play the ABC song “ABC Bing-Oh!” from Mr. Wee and Boo’s Wee-phabet Songs With A Fun Twist.
2. When your child hears a word that has the identified letter sound, he will clap, stomp, jump around, or create any fun and silly action. If the word does not have the sound, then your child will “freeze”.
3. The next time the song is listened to, try holding up the Wee-phabet Song cards to give your child a visual of the words being called out.
